Further, the tribal women of Shevaroy Hills learnt the art of making Herbal Tooth Powder, Herbal Soap, Herbal Bath Powder, Kumkum, Natural Pain relief Oil and Natural Sanitary Napkin.

To Empower the tribal women of Shevaroy Hills, ICT and Skill development training was organised in The Retreat.
